III. Through His death He made us children of God

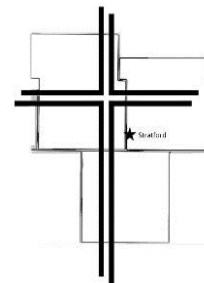
