Praise him with timbrel and dancing, praise him with the strings and pipe,

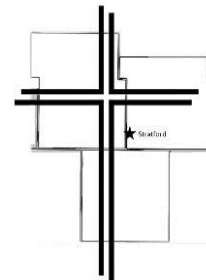
Praise him with the clash of cymbals, praise him with resounding cymbals.
